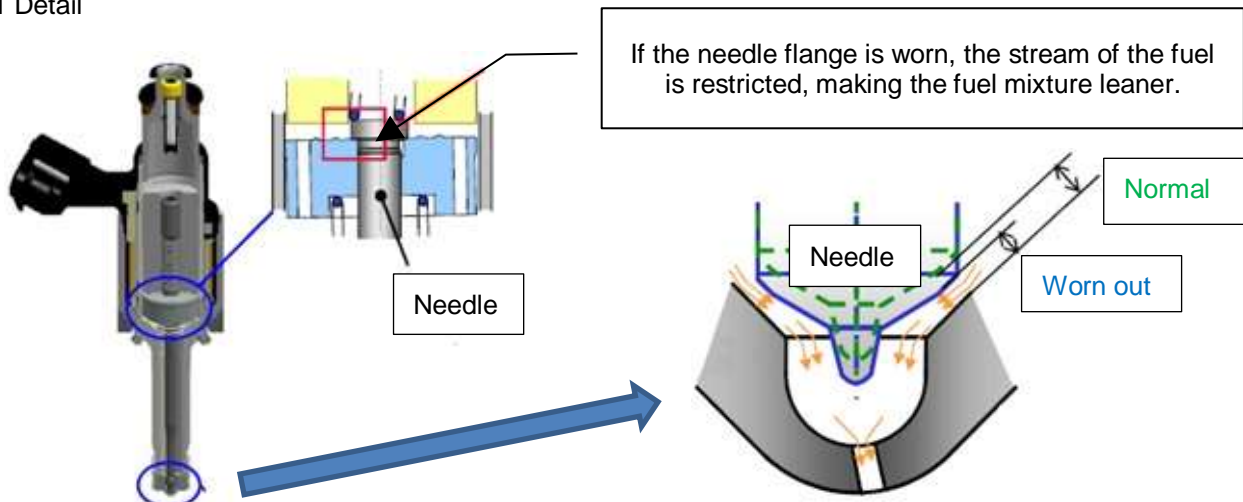

Symptom	Details of Symptom and Improvement
Customer experiences Knocking or vibration on DI engines, and DTC P030X (X can be any numerical number) is detected.	<p>Details of Symptom, Cause: Internal wear of the needle flange in the Injector makes the fuel mixture leaner, resulting in vibration and/or misfire of the engine. DTC P219A - D <AIR-FUEL RATIO IMBALANCE> can also be set.</p> <p>Details of countermeasure procedure: Change and optimize internal part to improve durability against wear. If it occurs, replace the Injector with new one on the cylinder of which misfire is being detected. (There is no need to replace all Injectors.)</p>

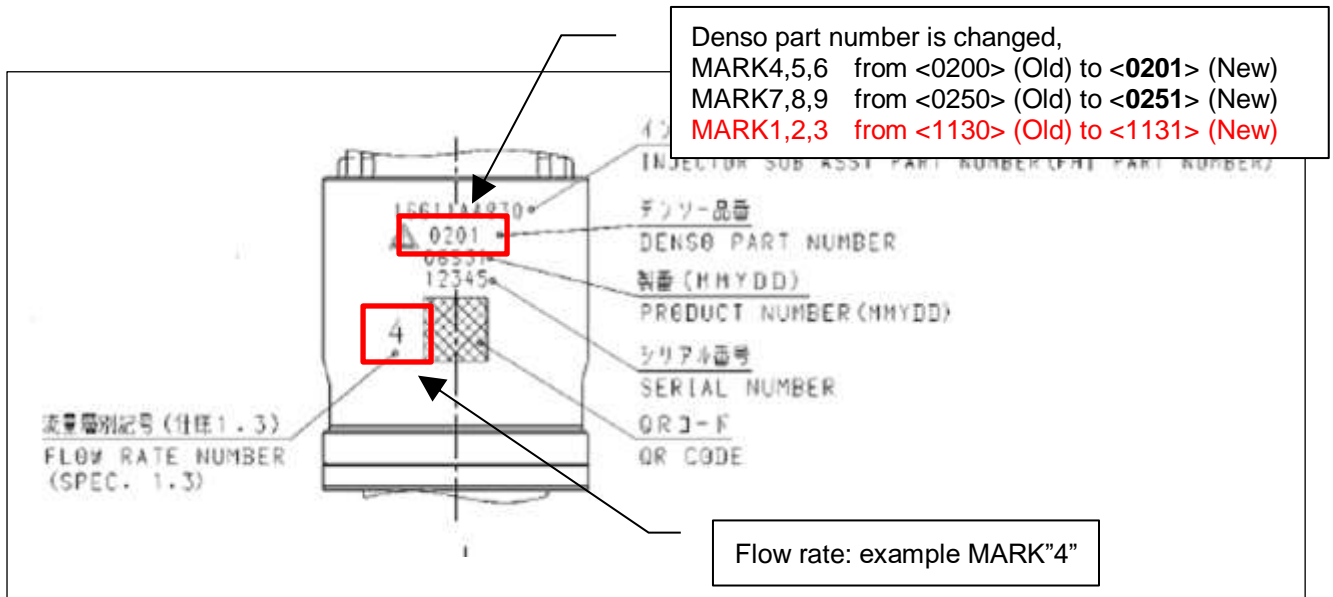
