




REVISION MARK: This mark highlights a change in installation with respect to previous issue.

The installation of this accessory must follow all instructions and use supplied hardware to ensure an approved quality installation.



1. Clean Front Mounting Area



- (a) Clean and degrease front body panel where splash guard is to be located with a clean cloth and soap/water mixture.

2. Hardware Removal and Install



- (a) Remove existing push pins locations A, B and C. Do not discard. (Fig. 2-1).

- (b) Remove existing push pin location E. Discard (Fig. 2-1).



- (c) Pull liner forward and install supplied spring clips (large) centered over fender edge hole locations B and C with turned up edge on inside of panel. (Fig. 2-1)



- (d) Reposition liner and reinstall previously removed push pin in location A. (Fig. 2-1)

3. Installation of Front Splash Guard



- (a) Mount splash guard on body panel and install supplied push pin (large) in location E while holding part up and into body panel. (Fig 3-1)



- (b) Install supplied 20mm screws in locations B and C while holding part up and into body panel then tighten.



- (c) While holding part in position, drill 8mm (5/16") hole in location D. (Fig 3-2)

- (d) Install supplied push pin (small) into location D while holding part into body panel.

- (e) Repeat procedure for other side.

4. Clean Rear Mounting Area And Wheel Removal

+ **NOTE: REMOVAL AND REINSTALLATION OF REAR WHEELS IS REQUIRED TO DRILL INNER LINER ATTACHMENT HOLES.**



- STOP** a) Clean and degrease rear bumper panel where splash guard is to be located with a clean cloth and soap/water mixture.
- b) Support vehicle and remove rear wheel. Follow owners manual procedure.


5. Identification of Rear Mount Locations

- !** (a) Remove existing push pins locations C and E. Do Not Discard (Fig. 5-1)
- (b) Pull bumper cover out at bottom and install supplied (large) spring clip centered over lower liner edge hole location C with turned up edge facing up. Then reposition bumper cover. (**STOP** Fig 5-1)

- (c) Install supplied spring clips (small) over panel edge holes locations A and B with turned up edge on inside of panel. (Fig. 5-2)


- !** (d) Reinstall existing push pins in locations D and E. (Fig. 5-2)






6. Installation Of Rear Splash Guard

- (a)  Mount splash guard and install supplied 20mm screw in location C while holding part up and into bumper panel and tighten. (Fig. 6-1)
- (b)  Install supplied 20mm screws in locations A and B while holding part up and into bumper panel and tighten. (Fig. 6-1).



- (c)  While holding part firmly against liner use part as a template and drill 8mm (5/16") hole in location E. (Fig. 6-2)



- (d)  Install supplied push pin into location E while holding part firmly against liner. (Fig. 6-3)
- (e) Reinstall rear wheel. Follow owner's manual procedure.
- (f) Repeat procedure for other side.

Checklist - these points **MUST** be checked to ensure a quality installation.

Gaps between mudguards and body side

Look For:

Excessive gaps greater than 1.0 mm.
